

## INFORMATION REGARDING THE PROCESSING OF PERSONAL DATA PURSUANT TO EUROPEAN REGULATION 2016/679 (art. 13) AND NATIONAL LAW IN FORCE

Please be informed that the personal data provided by you will be processed by EM MOULDS Spa which, as Data Controller, has prepared appropriate technical and organizational measures to ensure their protection. Personal data are information regarding an identified or identifiable natural person ("data subject"). "Processing" consists of operations carried out by means of computer tools or printed matter for (by way of example and not exhaustive) collecting, organizing and storing personal data.

### Which personal data we process, why we do it (legal bases and purposes) and how long we store them

We process personal data which do not belong to special categories (first name, last name, email address) to allow you to use the services offered by the website <https://www.coppermoulds.com/> ("site")

1. Contact the Data Controller: to receive answers to requests concerning information, suggestions, criticisms, assistance regarding the services of the site: the provision is optional but the Data Controller will not be able to process the request without this information
2. Receive promotional information to be updated regarding the services provided by the Data Controller the provision is optional and communications will be sent only in the case of explicit consent.

In the first case, data will be stored only for the purpose of managing the message for which it was entered

In the second case, on the basis of what we reasonably believe to be your expectations, the data will be stored until the consent given is withdrawn as described in the following paragraph "What are your rights and who you should contact to exercise them".

The following User information can be collected (so-called browsing data) when visiting the site, and stored in the server log files (hosting) of the site:

– internet protocol (IP) address;

- type of browser;
- parameters of the device used to connect to the site;
- name of the internet service provider (ISP);
- date and time of visit;
- web page of origin of the visitor (referral) and exit;

These data are used for statistical and analytical purposes, only in aggregate form.

The IP address is used only for safety reasons and is not cross-referenced with any other data.

The data collected by the site during operations are stored for the time strictly necessary to carry out the activities specified: the data (IP address) used for site security purposes (e.g.: blocking attempts to damage the site) are stored for 30 days.

Data for analytics (statistical) purposes is stored in aggregate format for 24 months.

### Who will have information regarding your data?

Personal data can be communicated to public authorities making a justified request, if such communication is required by law. Data processors (appointed pursuant to art. 28 EU Reg 2016/679) or authorized or designated personnel (art. 29 EU Reg - art. 2 quaterdecies D.Lgs. 101/2018), properly instructed and trained for this purpose by the Data Controller, may be informed about said data. The updated list of Data Processors may be requested from the Data Controller.

### Where are your data processed?

Data processing will be carried out at the premises of the Data Controller or Processors, on servers located in the European Union, using manual and computerized procedures, in compliance with all the necessary precautions to ensure the security and confidentiality of the information. The data will not be transferred to another country or to an international organisation.

### What are your rights and who do you need to contact to exercise them?

With reference to the aforementioned processing, the Data Subject may exercise all the rights referred to in Articles 15-22 of the European Regulation 2016/679 (including: access, rectification, cancellation, limitation, opposition, portability where this is not contrary to law or contractual obligations and is technically possible) by contacting the Data Controller by email to [privacy@coppermoulds.com](mailto:privacy@coppermoulds.com) or by written communication addressed to the Head Office (via Giorgio Saviane, 6 - 50127 Florence). With reference to data processing based on consent, the interested party has the right to withdraw said consent at any time without affecting the lawfulness of the processing based on the consent given before the withdrawal.
